National Guidance re. Bread and Wine at Communion

In the light of the current concerns about public health, the following guidance has been issued: If a person has any concerns about taking the winde form the Chalice, or feels unwell, has a sort throat or mouth ulcer, or if their immune system is compromised because of medical treatment, it is recommended to receive communion in the form of the Bread alone.

Otherwise sipping from the Chalice is the best way to receive the wine. Research indicates that there is no measurable risk from receiving the wind from the Chalice when it is properly administered, and careful hygiene is observed during the administration.
